### **OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM**

- Member schools will select their own representatives using their own criteria. For example, a letter of reference, interview, involvement of BVYLA alums, contact with parents, etc.
- **Student representatives shall include two per school** (with possible additions of a third on a case by case basis)
- Program runs from 3:00pm-5:30pm twice each month on Tuesdays from November through May
- Target population: 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grade 'emerging leaders' and/or those that really could use the extra leadership building skills
